



# Ag Efficiency Plus

## Program Involvement for Manufacturers, Dealers, and Installers

**Ag Efficiency Plus**, a component of Southern California Edison's Agricultural Energy Efficiency Program, is designed to help save your customers money by increasing their energy efficiency.

**Ag Efficiency Plus** offers agricultural and food processing customers free energy audits and rebates on energy efficient equipment. The program offers two types of rebates:

- Calculated rebates are based on the project's projected energy savings
- Itemized rebates are fixed for each measure on a per unit basis.

Follow these steps to ensure that your satisfied customer moves through the program and receives a rebate.

1. Visit the dealer section of [www.agefficiencyplus.com](http://www.agefficiencyplus.com). Register here to make sure you receive the latest program updates and dealer information. You can also download forms and program materials from this site.
2. Talk with your customers about the program's energy efficiency opportunities. Call the **Ag Efficiency Plus** hotline at **1-800-791-7541** at any time for additional information or with questions.
3. Work with **Ag Efficiency Plus** to determine if an audit, or calculated rebates or itemized rebates are the right choice for your customer.
4. Once paperwork is properly completed and it is determined that your customer qualifies, your customer should receive a rebate check for the qualifying installations from Southern California Edison within four weeks.

Work with <b>Ag Efficiency Plus</b> to secure rebates for your customer on the recommended energy efficiency measures</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Make sure your customer schedules a pre-inspection <u>before</u> installation and applies for approval <u>before</u> installing equipment.</li> <li>2. After the customer receives project approval, proceed with installation promptly.</li> <li>3. Help your customer compile and submit project invoices along with an Installation Completion Report.</li> <li>4. Make sure your customer schedules a post-installation inspection.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Review application terms and conditions to ensure that the proposed equipment qualifies.</li> <li>2. Install equipment.</li> <li>3. Help your customer complete and submit an <b>Ag Efficiency Plus</b> application along with invoices and manufacturers' specifications.</li> <li>4. Make sure your customer schedules a post-installation inspection if the total project rebate exceeds \$3,000.</li> </ol>

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
